#### Deposits

#### **Unused vouchers**

The Club will stop selling session vouchers from 17<sup>th</sup> March and vouchers can no longer be used for Table Money from 31<sup>st</sup> March.

Unused vouchers can be redeemed using the envelopes provided at the front of the club – fill out the front of the envelope and place in the black box provided. The proceeds will be deposited into your Compa\$\$ account.

#### Mycompasss.com

If you wish to access your account to keep track of your spending, view your current balance or download a statement, you will need to register at <u>mycompasss.com</u> (note there are three "s").

Registration here is not a requirement for the Compa\$\$ system to work.
