Team Events 2026

Coming up in the programme for 2026 will be more Team Events.

Following feedback at the AGM and as we have more players moving into the open section next year, we have reviewed the Teams Policy to allow for more than one open player per team. I would like to draw your attention to the changes:

• Rating points for team members are set at:

Open player – 3 points Intermediate player – 2 points Junior player – 1 point

- Each team must consist of no more than 8 rating points in total. This allows for team combinations of, for example:
 - 2 x Open & 2 x Junior members (open do not play together)
 - 1 x Open, 2 x Intermediate, 1 x Junior
 - 4 x Intermediate members
- Substitutes are permitted in all Team events, provided the maximum of 8 team rating points for the Team are not exceeded.
