Intermediate & Junior Tournament - Saturday 19 October 9.30 am Sponsored by Northbridge

Separate competitions for Juniors and Intermediates run side by side. Entry is online at NZ Bridge.

For those of you unsure about online entry, here's what you do: If you have not logged into the NZ Bridge website previously you will need to contact the club to get an access code number - this is NOT your ID number. Email the club and Heather will provide you with this code before you start.

Go to <u>nzbridge.co.nz</u>, go to LOGIN, scroll down to REGISTER, enter your access code then BEGIN.

Once you have completed your registration and are logged in, follow the steps listed below.

(If you have previously registered, just login.)

Click on "Tournament List", scroll down to the list of tournaments (they are in red and in chronological order), scroll down to 19 October, there are two separate entries for North Shore, select Intermediate or Junior and click on "Enter Here". Your details should already be recorded. Scroll down to the bottom of the page and enter your partner's name in the box marked "Player 2".

You will receive an email confirming your entry.

Tablet Management

To make it easier for those tasked with cleaning and charging the tablets at the end of a session, players please **<u>DO NOT</u>** shut down your tablet once you have viewed your pair's ranking.

Tableteers

- 1. BEFORE cleaning the tablet move it forward using the red arrow (bottom right)
- 2. When it asks "do you want to end this session?" tap 'yes'.
- 3. Now that the "START" page is showing you may switch the tablet off by holding down the on/off button
- 4. The screen will show two options: OFF (black) and RESTART (green). Tap OFF.
- 5. Once the tablet has been correctly switched off, you may clean it.
- 6. Only tablets with three or less bars need to be put on the charger.

Checking Compa\$\$

Please get into the habit of checking your balance regularly and top up when necessary. This will save Mike an awful lot of extra work sending out low balance warnings.

To check your balance, go to <u>mycompasss.com</u> (Note: three "s"). Click on "Check your wallet". Enter your Username and password and you should be good to go. If you have forgotten your Username, contact Mike. He may be able to help you.
